

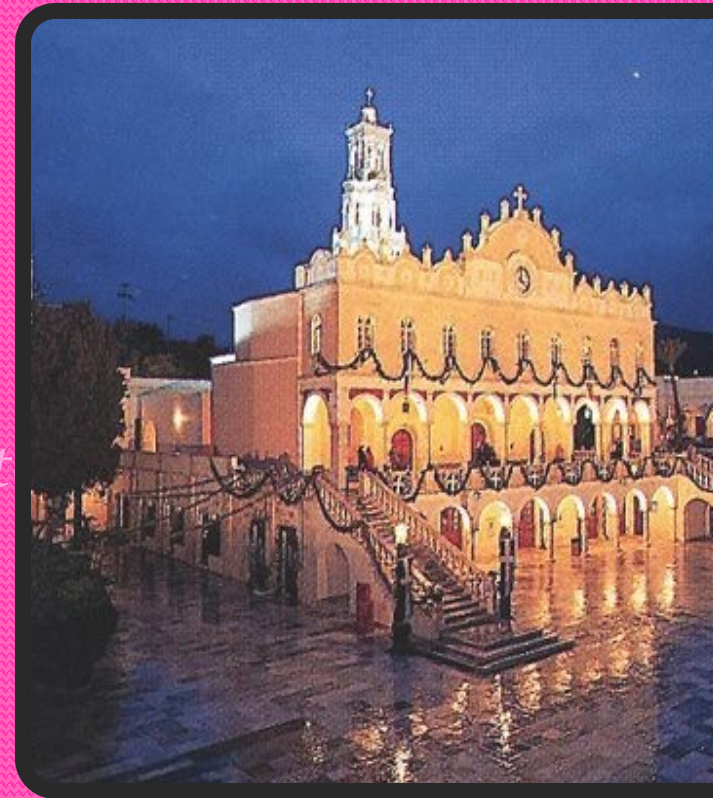
Location

- **Tinos** is a Greek island situated in the Aegean Sea. It is located in the Cyclades archipelago. In antiquity, Tinos was also known as **Ophiussa** (from Greek *ophis* 'snake').



What is Tinos most known of;

- *Tinos is mostly renowned for being a major tourist and religious site for Orthodox Greeks. Every year, thousands of pilgrims are coming to the island for the Assumption of the Virgin Mary. During this pilgrimage, people are walking on their knees up to the Church of Panagia Evangelistria.*



Places to visit

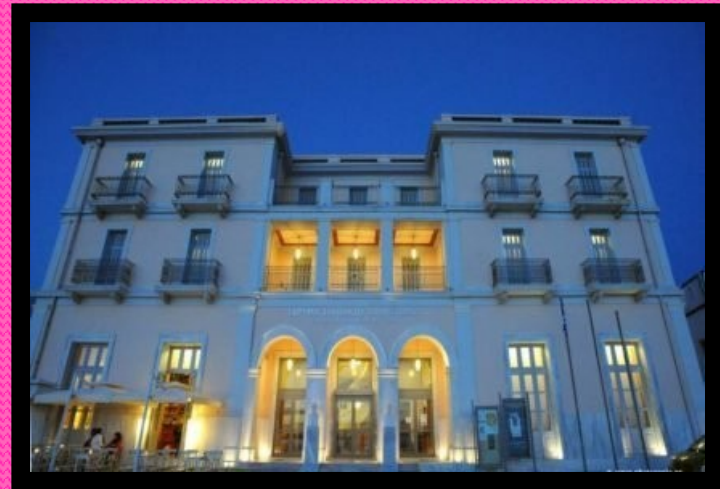


- *There is an Archaeological Museum in Tinos town, which contains artifacts from the Sanctuary of Poseidon and Amphitrite. The excavation of the sanctuary can be seen in Kionia about 4 km of the town.*
