- Q** **QUOTABLE** If someone used the words in your post to define you, how would you be remembered?
- U** **UNDERSTANDABLE** What is your tone?
- E** **ESSENTIAL** Is what you are saying crucial to the situation or conversation?
- T** **TRUSTWORTHY** Do your words portray you as someone in whom people can confide?
- T** **TRUE** Just don't lie. Ever.
- E** **EXACTLY WHAT YOU INTENDED** Overall, does your post convey what you intended?
